Information provided for the answer:

Thank you for your recent request.

I have considered your request and having liaised with the relevant department, I have been advised that the current number of vaccinated people who are not presented in the groups listed in the dashboard will include social care workers and also clinically extremely vulnerable patients, who are now being to be called for vaccination. The data categories for these groups will be added to the surveillance reports shortly. There is also a number of vaccinations recorded in the Welsh Immunisation System for individuals whose data are incomplete and work is underway to allocate information to the correct groups when their data allows.
