Thank you for your recent request. Information regarding reporting of Covid 19 at Dawn Meats Cross Hands, and any hospitalisation of employees or self-isolating requirements following diagnoses is not available. Information about small numbers of individuals would not be released because of patient confidentiality. Public Health Wales does not inspect factories.
