Email correspondence and related email attachments between officials from Public Health Wales and 2 Sisters Food Group.

### Information provided for the answer:

Thank you for your recent request. Attached are a number of documents that relate to your request, these include emails, word documents and Power Point presentations.

Some documents have been retained due to the fact that it is solely personal information in the attachments. These were spreadsheets that contained the names, contact details, addresses and test results of staff that either work at 2 Sisters, contractors that have visited the sites, or supplier/partner information that has been withheld due to commercial sensitivity.

There are also some redactions to emails where personal information was included in the body of the email.

Photographs of staff 2 Sisters staff members, demonstrating the new working practices have also been removed from the PowerPoint presentations.
