



I am clearer now, this tender was for patient note folders, which Public Health Wales does not use. As a public health organisation we rarely have direct contact with the public except for our screening teams who have unique folders that hold images as well as consultation notes. You will need to contact the all Wales procurement teams for this inquiry, I assume that if this contract is up for renewal they would handle it, though, I am unaware if this team existed at the time of the original contract as NHS Wales has re-organised in the meantime.
