

## **Re; Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000**

Thank you for your request of 4<sup>th</sup> June 2014 seeking information on 'all communications relating in any way to my employment between Head of the Nursing Bank at Betwsil Cadwalader NHS Health Trust and yourself from 27/05/2014 to 02/06/2014.'

Under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 we are unable to supply you with this information as it falls under exemption S40 - the information requested is your personal data.

However we are able to supply the information you request under the Data Protection Act 1998 as we do hold information about you and can supply this. We cannot supply information we hold about anybody else. We cannot supply information held about you by Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board and advise you to contact them separately requesting your information.

Under the Data Protection Act we have up to 40 days to supply you with this information.

If you are unhappy with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of the decision, you should write to the Corporate Complaints Manager, Public Health Wales NHS Trust, 14 Cathedral Road, Cardiff, CF11 9LJ

If you are not content with the outcome of your complaint or review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
