Information requested:

I would like to know how many (numbers only not names) Diabetic Retinopathy staff received Safeguarding training (violence against women) between 2010 and 2015, and what percentage of staff this represents.

Information provided for the answer

Diabetic Retinopathy Screening Wales, now Diabetic Eye Screening Wales moved from Cardiff & Vale Health Board to Public Health Wales in April 2016. From 2010 to 2015 only front line screening staff having direct patient contact in clinics, which includes those staff undertaking Healthcare Assistant or Retinal Photography duties, were required to undertake safeguarding adults training (previously Protection of Vulnerable Adults) under the mandatory training requirements of Cardiff & Vale UHB. We cannot confirm that these modules specifically referenced 'violence against women' as the training was provided by another organisation.

The box below shows the job titles and dates of DESW staff, because of the variety of dates the training was undertaken, it is not possible to provide the percentage of staff this represents.
