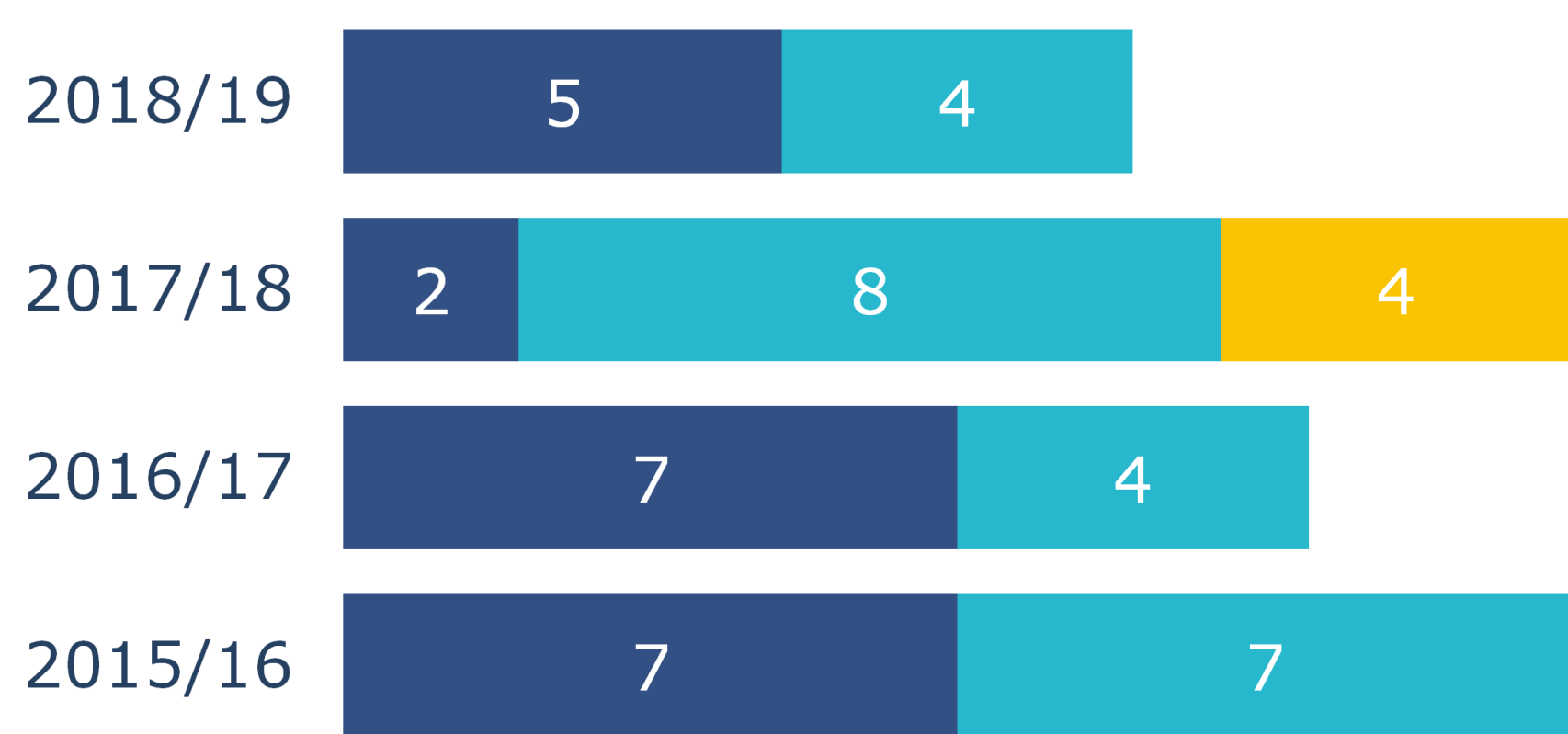


INFLUENZA SEASON IN WALES 2018/19

Dominant types of influenza A(H1N1) & A(H3N2)

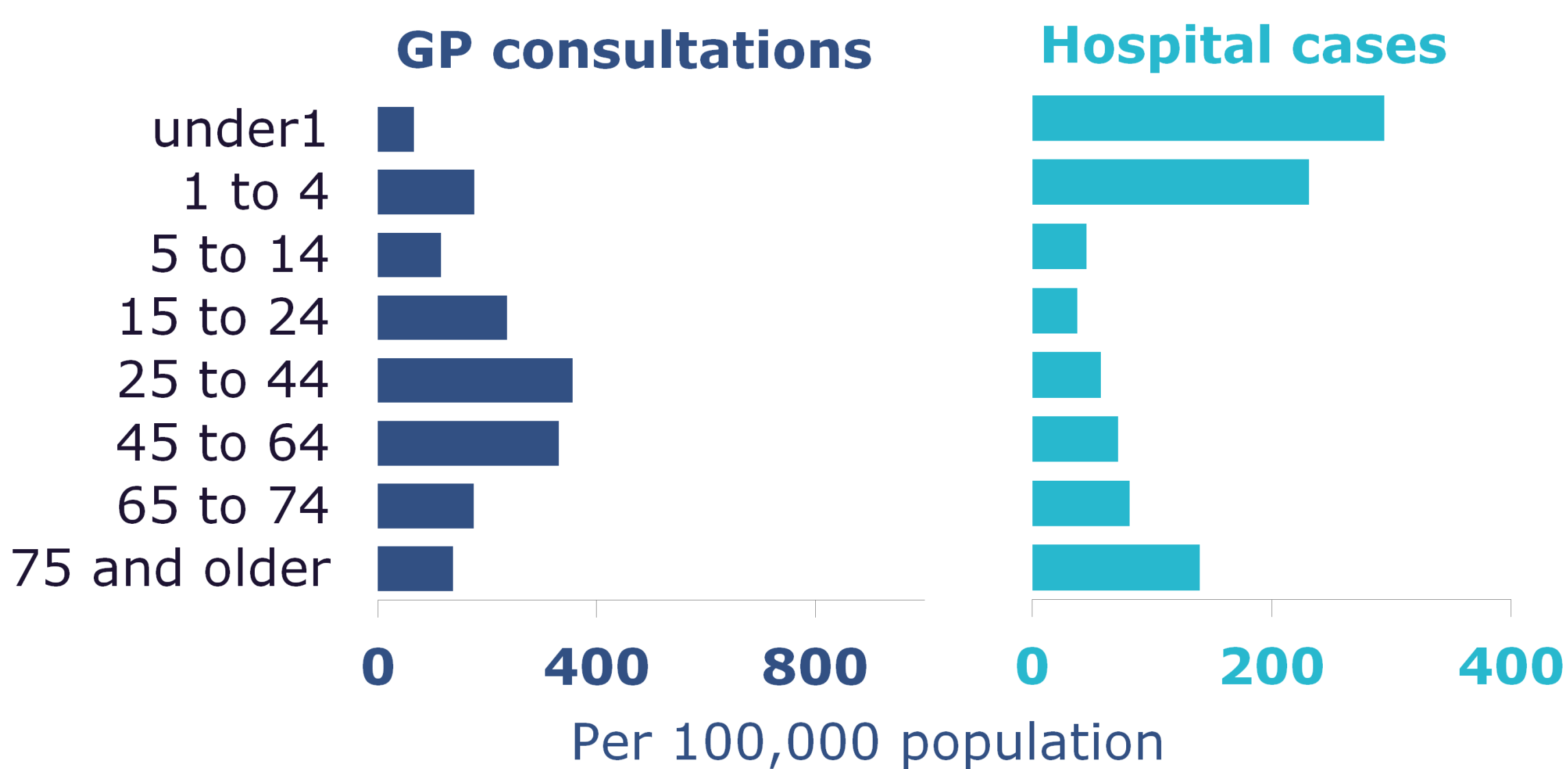


Number of weeks at:

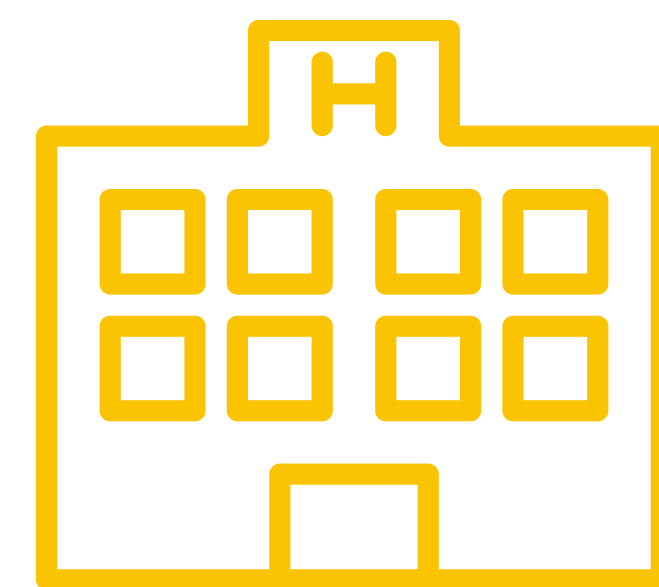

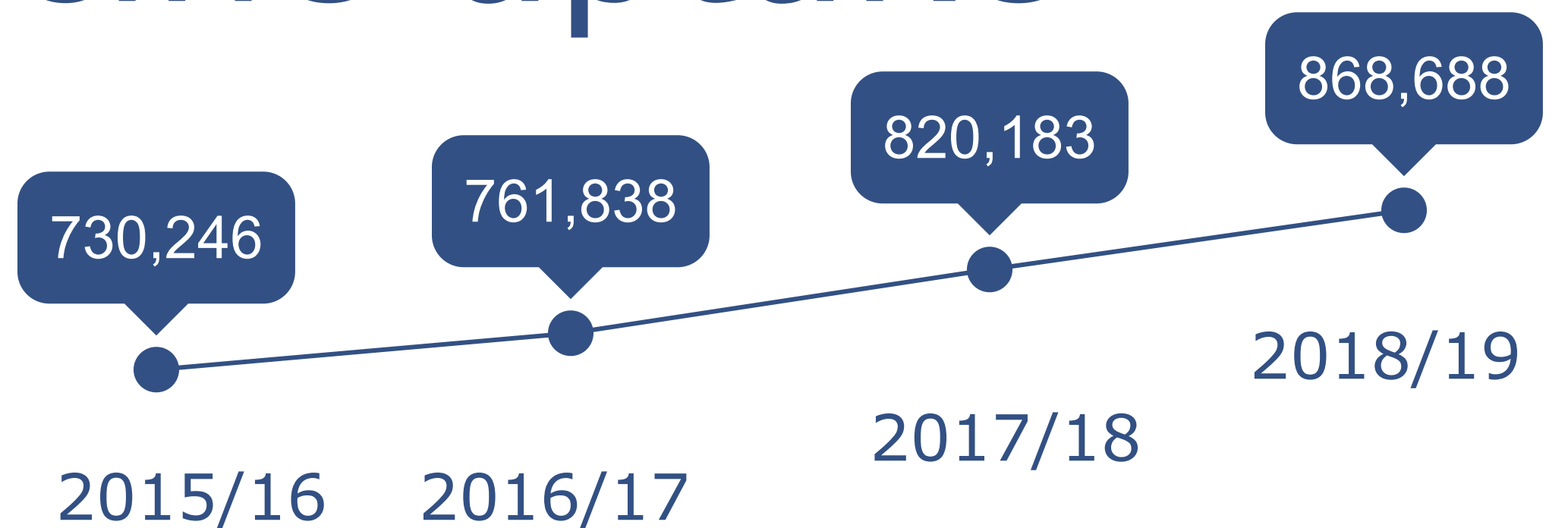
